Summary	A substance of very high concern (SVHC) is a chemical substance for which it has been proposed that the use within the European Union be subject to authorization under the REACH Regulation. If a substance is identified as an SVHC, it will be added to the Candidate List for eventual inclusion in the Authorization List (Annex XIV). The first list of SVHCs was published on October 28th, 2008 and the list is updated bi-annually to include new candidates, with the last update occurring on January 12th, 2017 to include a total 173 SVHCs.
Scope	All articles entering the EU market. This includes all parts going into the article.
